If you like something, pick up the bidding sheet and item and take both to any cashier (even if you are pre-pay) to add the item to your invoice. If you have a question or a problem, go to Customer Service in the Commons.

Silent Auction Rules

1. The Silent Auction will open for bidding at 5:30 p.m., and will begin closing at 6:50 p.m., section by section.
2. Your bid number is on the program you received upon entry to the auction.
3. All bids must be in whole dollar amounts.
4. All items in the Silent Auction have bid sheets in front of them. Persons desiring to bid must do so by writing their bid number and the amount of their bid on the sheet.
5. Each increase in bid has been preprinted for you. If you choose to make a higher bid than the next available preprinted amount, please put a line through the undesired spaces until you reach your desired bid amount.
6. The closing bid circled by a Shepherd of the Lakes Auction Committee Member constitutes the winning bid. All incorrect bids will be declared void.
7. In the event of a dispute, a Shepherd of the Lakes Auction Committee Member will act as the final authority and shall determine the winning bidder. Under no circumstances may the auction bid sheet be removed from the bidding table. In the event that a bid sheet is missing, the item will be pulled from the Silent Auction.
8. All sales are final. There will be no exchanges or refunds in items unless noted. While every reasonable effort has been made to describe each item correctly, all items and services are sold “where is” and “as is”.
9. Payment in full on the evening of the auction is required for all items or services. Purchases may be made by cash, check, Visa, MasterCard or Discover only. Checks should be made to Shepherd of the Lakes. Payment by cash or check will allow SOTL to avoid being charged the credit card handling fees.
10. All items must be taken home by the successful bidder this evening. Items may be claimed only by showing “paid” receipt to the Auction Committee Member in charge of pick up.
11. Unless otherwise specified, dates and times are to be arranged at the mutual convenience of the donor or the buyer. The buyer is responsible for contacting the donor for all items and services. The buyer is responsible for being aware of exclusions, time limit, requirements, etc. stated on the gift certificates, tickets, or donor forms.

Live Auction Rules

1. The Live Auction will begin approximately at 8:00 p.m.
2. To enter a bid, the bidder must raise his/her program booklet, showing his/her number to attract the attention of the Auctioneer. This process must be repeated each time you initiate or increase a bid.
3. If the Auctioneer determines that an opening bid or any subsequent bid is not commensurate with the value of the item offered, he may reject the same and withdraw the item from sale. He may also reject an advance he deems to be an insufficient amount. The Auctioneer has the right to start the bidding at a level he considers appropriate, to add or delete any item, and to announce conditions of sale at any time.
